

Summer School 2018

In-District Professional Educator Pay and Related Information



In-district professional educators will be paid at their per diem rate up to \$32/hour for all planning and teaching hours in Summer School 2018.

- In-district Summer School 2018 professional educator pay will be paid at per diem up to \$32/hour.
 - Per diem pay up to \$32/hour for both planning and teaching time.
- In-district Summer School 2018 professional educators whose per diem pay is less than \$25/hour will be paid at the \$25/hour pay rate (no in-district professional educator will be paid less than \$25/hour).
- Planning time will be moved into the “teaching day” timeframe and will be paid at the same rate as teaching. We will no longer have a teaching rate of pay and a planning rate of pay. (Last year the rate was \$25/hour for all planning time).
 - Planning time will be increased overall by 90 minutes
 - 22 days X 45 minutes = 990 minutes (16.5 hours)
- There will be no paid planning time prior to the start of summer school, instead the planning time has been worked into increased daily planning time.
 - Professional educators may use the additional planning time provided in each day to pre-plan for summer school.
- Each “regular” day (June and July classes) will include
 - 4 hours of face-face teaching time with students (paid at per diem up to \$32/hour)
 - 45 minutes of planning time (paid at per diem up to \$32/hour)
 - Increase of 15 minutes daily and 90 minutes overall for the summer
- If there is a specialized class that runs beyond the standard four hours, an additional 10 minutes of planning time will be added for every additional hour that is taught in the day.
 - These classes and the time involved will be pre-arranged prior to the start of Summer School 2018.
- Professional educators are paid for planning and teaching on the days they are present in Summer School 2018.
- In case of an absence, all staff are required to arrange their substitutes from either the substitute listing or with a staff member from the same employment category in the district.
