Please watch for these letters in your mail prior to June 18, 2018. There is no need to call the district or school office to ask for this information, it will be coming in the mail.

Registration for students after May 2018

Q: Is it possible to register students for Summer School now?

A: Yes! Please see details on pages 2 & 3 for the various age groups and classes.

- Parents/guardians of current 5th graders may continue to register for New Beginnings until June 29, 2018.

- Parents/guardians of **current 7th graders** may continue to register for Keys to Success until June 29, 2018.

- Parents/guardians of **current 5th-11th graders** may register for Strength and Conditioning up to and during Summer School. Parents/guardians can register through the attached form until June 9, 2017. After June 20, 2018, students may go to the High School strength and conditioning room to register with the teachers.

- For all other classes, parents/guardians of **elementary, middle, and upper middle level** students need to go to the main office of the Summer School site (see sites below) on or after Wednesday, June 20, 2018. (Offices are open from 8:00-12:00, Monday-Thursday.) The secretary or welcome center greeter will do the following:
 - Ask the parent/guardian for the student's identification (ID) number.
 - Ask the parent/guardian the names of classes in which the student would like to register.
 - All students requesting to register for reading or math classes will be placed in the classes.
 - Parents/guardians should have multiple selections in mind for enrichment classes, as many/most enrichment classes will be filled.
 - Students will only be placed in classes where there are openings.
 - The secretary or welcome center greeter will register the student for the class(es) in which there are openings.
 - The student may start Summer School on the following day (Thursday, June 21, 2018).
 - K-8 Summer School Sites:
 - C.H. Bird - for C.H. Bird and Westside students
 - Creekside - for Creekside and Royal Oaks students
 - Horizon - for Horizon students
 - Northside - for Northside and Eastside students

- Prairie View Middle School - Middle and Upper Middle Summer School
- All **Prairie Phoenix Academy students** have been registered for Summer School sessions at PPA. Parents/guardians or students with questions may contact Lisa Bollinger at labolli@sunprairieschools.org or 608.834.6901.
- Parents/guardians of **high school students or the student** may contact Brittany Browning, at the district office, 608.834.6507, or bdbrown@sunprairieschools.org at any time to register for Credit Recovery classes or the enrichment classes and AP boot camps held in the afternoons or during late July or early August.

Q: May parents/guardians register their children for district provided transportation (busing) after the MAY 4, 2018 deadline?

A: NO. The May 4, 2018 bus transportation registration deadline was established to provide the district and the bus company time to develop the bus routes for Summer School. No additional students are added after the May 4, 2018 deadline.

- The Summer School team advertised the May 4, 2018 deadline to families in numerous ways including direct emails to parents/guardians, announcements at schools, information on the website, in the course guide, and on the district facebook page.



Q: How do parents/guardians make payments for Summer School?

A: Parents/guardians who are registering their child at a school site after the start of Summer School or are adding a class:

- May pay at the summer school site at the time you register your child
- May mail or drop off a payment at the District Office
