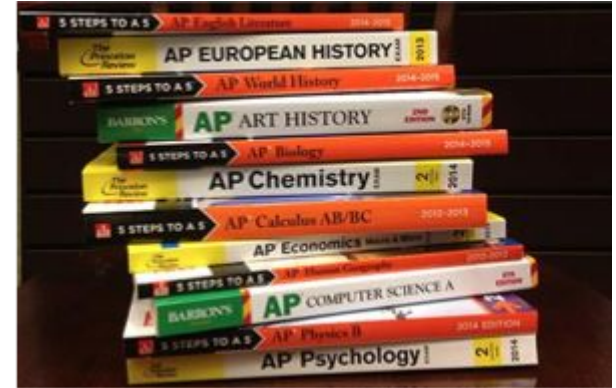

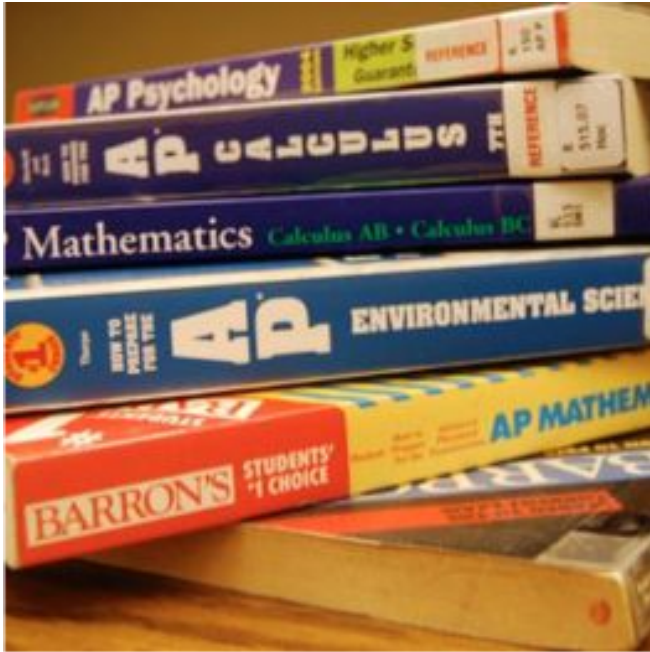

- Must pay by check or credit card (on Infinite Campus) within 24 hours

2018 AP Exam Dates

in May of 2017, Sun Prairie High School students took 24 Advanced Placement exams. In addition, approximately 561 students took 919 exams! We had 131 AP Scholars, including 3 with National AP Scholar recognition.

We are happy to announce that we are offering 26 Advanced Placement courses during the 2017-2018 school year.

How to register for the AP Exam

Students can register for their AP exam(s) in the link below. The exam fee is \$94 per exam and must be paid in full within one day of registering for the exam. Students may pay by credit on Infinite Campus through the fees tab, or by check or money order. Students taking multiple exams may pay with one check, and all checks and money orders must be payable to Sun Prairie High School. Note: Checks and money orders should be submitted to Meghan Bosonetta (room 3410) or to Whitney Higley (main office).

Although registration is now done online, students are still required to submit a Transportation Form acknowledging that they provide their own transportation to and from exams. This form will be distributed by AP teachers at the end of January. Please note that students will not be registered to take their exams until this Transportation Form is signed and returned to Meghan Bosonetta (room 3410).

Every student who registers to take an AP exam must attend an Advanced Placement Pre-Administration Session in April. Details will be updated on this website when they are finalized.

Students who chose not to test after they have registered will have the option of reimbursement of all but \$25 for each exam. The \$25 will be used to cover the unused exam fee to CollegeBoard and to cover the cost of processing the exam.

Wisconsin Statute 1200.12(22) requires the Sun Prairie School District to pay for Advanced Placement exams for students who qualify for free and reduced priced lunch. If your child receives free and/or reduced priced lunches, a copy of the eligibility notification letter must be given to Meghan Bosonetta or Whitney Higley by February 9, 2018.

The registration for AP tests, payments, and transportation forms must be turned in no later than FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 9, 2018 at 3:30pm. If you have any questions, please contact Meghan Bosonetta, AP Coordinator, at (608) 834-6865 or email at miboson@sunprairieschools.org.
