The scholarship will be awarded after the student submits an enrollment verification letter (please include your student ID number with the letter) from the two-year or four-year college. School and community service is highly recommended.

To qualify, the applicant must be:

1. An ethnic minority and/or underrepresented student
2. A U.S. citizen or permanent resident
3. A graduating senior from a Dane County area High School with a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or higher
4. Able to attend the Links Scholarship Award Ceremony (May 7, 2018)

To apply, applicant must:

1. Complete and sign the scholarship application form
2. Secure parental signature if applicant is under 18 years of age
3. Write a 500-750 word essay on one of the scholarship topics
4. Submit a copy of their ACT or SAT scores
5. Submit an official transcript with an official seal stamp of high school grades in a separate sealed envelope
6. Submit an official photo (headshot)
